International observational study To Understand the impact and **BEst** practices of airway management in critically ill patients

## Why?

To evaluate the impact of intubation-related adverse events and current clinical practice of airway management in the in-hospital critical care setting.

## How?

Through a prospective observational multicenter cohort study aiming to assess 1000 ETI-related major complications from 120 centers worldwide.

## Which patients?

All adult ( $\geq 18$  year) critically ill patients undergoing in-hospital ETI. We will exclude patients undergoing ETI during cardiac arrest or anesthesia.

## When?

During a 8-week period of choice between 1 October 2018 and 31 March 2019
